

MEMORIZING SCRIPTURE TOGETHER

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly ... (Colossians 3:16)

JANUARY

Truth: God is the sovereign creator and loving ruler of all things.

Revelation 4:11 - *You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created.*

FEBRUARY

Truth: God is holy and righteous.

Deuteronomy 32:3-4 - *Ascribe greatness to our God. He is the Rock, His work is perfect; for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice; righteous and upright is He.*

MARCH

Truth: Man is sinful.

Romans 3:10-12 - *There is none righteous, no, not one; there is none who understands; there is none who seeks after God. They have all turned aside; they have together become unprofitable; there is none who does good, no, not one.*

APRIL

Truth: God is just and right to punish sin.

Romans 1:18 - *For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness.*

MAY

Truth: No amount of good works can make man right with God.

Galatians 3:10-11 - *For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them." But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for "the just shall live by faith."*

JUNE

Truth: God is gracious and merciful to underserving sinners.

Ephesians 2:4-5 - *But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).*

JULY

Truth: God placed the punishment of sinners on Jesus

1 Peter 3:18a - *For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God.*

2 Corinthians 5:21 - *For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.*

AUGUST

Truth: The death of Jesus brings forgiveness and freedom from guilt.

1 Peter 2:24 - *Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.*

SEPTEMBER

Truth: The resurrection of Jesus brings new and eternal life.

1 Peter 1:3 - *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.*

OCTOBER

Truth: God offers His gift of forgiveness and new life to all who repent and believe.

Romans 10:9-10 - *That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

NOVEMBER

Truth: Those who have come to Jesus for salvation will live their lives for Him.

2 Corinthians 5:14-15 - *For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.*

DECEMBER

Truth: As followers of Jesus, we are to proclaim the Gospel to all men.

2 Corinthians 5:20 - *Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.*
